

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

1. When will IIM Visakhapatnam commence its academic session for PGP 2018-20 batch?

IIM Visakhapatnam will commence its academic session in July 2018.

2. Who will receive email for reconfirmation of interest for admissions to IIM Visakhapatnam?

IIM Visakhapatnam will send an email (at the email address provided by the candidate in CAT 2017 registration form) to the candidates meeting both the criteria listed below:

- Have applied to IIM Visakhapatnam at the time of CAT 2017 registration, and
- All the candidates who meet the eligibility condition in Table 1 of the Admissions Process document

3. What are the admission requirements at IIM Visakhapatnam?

- Candidates should have opted for IIM Visakhapatnam during registration for CAT 2017, and
- Candidates should secure the minimum percentile mentioned in the Table below in each category in CAT 2017, to be shortlisted for Phase-1 of the admission process

* these cut-offs are not for admission offers whose scores could be much higher

- Candidates shortlisted in Phase-1, should reconfirm their interest by the third week April 2018 to be considered for subsequent stages of the admission process.
- 4. I am eligible for consideration for admission to IIM Visakhapatnam based on the CAT cut-offs, and would like to reconfirm my interest in the candidature. But I did not receive the email seeking reconfirmation of interest. What should I do?**

Please refer to the CAT2017 advertisement wherein you are informed to maintain an email id throughout the admission process. However, if your email address (provided in the CAT 2017 registration form) has now become invalid, you should log-in to the admissions page on the IIMV website with your registered email ID and while reconfirming your interest, you can provide an alternate email id. Any further communication will be sent to both the email-ids.

5. I was shortlisted in phase-1 and have reconfirmed my interest by the due date. What will be the next stage of admission?

In Phase-2, from among the reconfirmed candidates a second shortlist will be announced for the personal interview stage.

- Candidates who have been shortlisted in phase-2 of IIMV, but have also been shortlisted / interviewed (only for PGP/ PGPM Program 2018) by any one or more of the IIMs at Bangalore, Calcutta, Kozhikode, Indore, Lucknow, will not have to appear for personal interview for IIM Visakhapatnam. The scores of the personal interviews / Written Ability Test at these IIMs will be considered by IIMV.
- Candidates who have been shortlisted in phase-2 of IIMV, but have not been shortlisted / interviewed by any of the above IIMs will be required to appear for a Personal Interview / Written Ability Test to be conducted by IIMV.

6. What are the fees for PGP at IIM Visakhapatnam?

The fees for the PGP 2018-20 batch is INR 10.5 lakhs for the two-year programme.

7. How much do I have to pay while accepting my admission offer?

You will need to pay an initial acceptance fee of INR 50,000/- . More details about the payment will be sent along with the admission offer.

8. Which is the mentor institute for IIM Visakhapatnam?

IIM Bangalore is the mentor institute for IIM Visakhapatnam.

9. How will placements be handled at IIM Visakhapatnam?

Career Development Services (CDS) Office of the mentor institute will oversee placements.

10. Where will classes for IIM Visakhapatnam be conducted?

IIM Visakhapatnam is currently located in the Andhra University Campus. Please refer to the institute website (www.iimv.ac.in) for details.
