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Indian Institute of Management Visakhapatnam (IIMV) was established in 2015, with its library designated as the Learning Resource Centre (LRC). Over the years, it has grown into a leading management information center nationwide, leveraging advanced technology to support its users. Our mission at the LRC is to provide easy and user-friendly access to up-to-date, global, and relevant information, catering to the diverse needs of the academic community at IIMV for teaching, research, consulting, training, and learning purposes.

As an integral part of the academic and research endeavors on campus, the Library is committed to offering state-of-the-art facilities and innovative services to support teaching, learning, research, and outreach activities. With a user-centric approach, library continuously design and deliver need-based information services.

The Learning Resource Centre serves as a hub for academic and professional knowledge resources, facilitating knowledge creation through electronic search platforms and access to a wide range of research materials both on and off campus. Our collection primarily focuses on literature related to Business, Management, and allied fields, aligning closely with the Institute's educational objectives.

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The library holds a rich collection of printed and electronic resources, including books, journals, newspapers, e-databases, reports, case studies, and more. Subscriptions to electronic resources such as ACE Analyser, Business Source Complete -EBSCO, Emerald Insight, Elsevier Science Direct journals, among others, enhance our offerings. IIMV Library is fully computerized library using an Open-Source Software KOHA-LMS for its housekeeping operations.

To further assist users, specialized tools like EBSCO Discovery, journal title search, remote login (restricted to internal users), Eikon Terminal and Kindle E-Book Readers Borrowing Service are provided. Additionally, campus-wide access to digital resources is facilitated through subscriptions to e-databases and e-journals, allowing users to access library materials from their own computer terminals in real-time.

In essence, the Learning Resource Centre at IIMV is dedicated to providing comprehensive resources and services to support the academic and research endeavours of the Institute's community.

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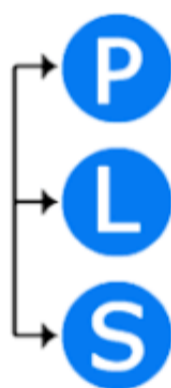

## Services offered by Library

1. **OPAC( Online Public Access Catalogue):** An OPAC is a digital database that provides users with access to a library's collection. It allows patrons to search for books, journals, articles, and other materials using various search facilities such as title, author, subject, and keywords.

1. **Kindle E-Readers :** The library provides patrons with access to two Kindle readers, allowing them to enjoy reading e-books conveniently. These devices are available for loan, enabling users to experience the extensive digital library that Kindle offers, including a vast selection of e-books spanning various genres and subjects. The availability of Kindle readers supports the library's mission to make reading accessible to everyone.



3. **Inter Library Loan Services :** Interlibrary Loan (ILL) Services facilitate the borrowing and lending of materials between different libraries within a network or consortium. This service allows library patrons to access materials that are not available in their library collection by borrowing them from other sister libraries.

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**4. Current Awareness Services :** Current Awareness Services (CAS) is the services aimed at helping users stay informed about the most recent and relevant developments in their areas of interest. Library offer CAS through various channels, such as email alerts, WhatsApp notifications, and other digital means, ensuring timely updates on new journal issues, books, and other documents. These services ensure that users have access to the most current information, enabling them to stay ahead in their academic, professional, and personal endeavors.

**5. RemoteXs Facility:** The RemoteXs facility provides seamless remote access to a library's electronic resources, enabling users to access academic content from anywhere. This service is especially valuable for students, researchers, and faculty members who need to utilize library resources while off-campus or on the go. The facility offers 24/7 access to e-journals, e-books, databases, and other digital content, ensuring convenience and flexibility.

**6. Media Alert Services :** The Library facilitate access to news articles pertaining to our institute by gathering relevant information from newspapers and distributing it to our patrons as media alerts. These alerts serve as timely notifications, keeping our patrons informed about the latest developments, events, and accomplishments associated with our institution.

**7. User orientations:** These are comprehensive sessions aimed at introducing new patrons to the library's resources, services, and facilities. These programs are crucial for helping users navigate the library effectively and utilize its offerings to their fullest potential. During a user orientation, participants are guided through various aspects of the library, including how to locate books, journals, and other materials, both in print and online. They learn about the library's catalog system, databases, and other digital resources available for research and study.



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**8. Digital Information Services:** LRC provides Digital Information Services, which likely encompass a range of electronic resources and services aimed at supporting teaching, learning, and research activities. These services may include access to online databases, e-journals, e-books, and other digital materials. The Library computing facilities and database access is meant only for Faculty, Research Scholars and students of IIMV.

**9. Circulation Services:** LRC provides general access to collection and a full range of loan services. Information about all library transactions such as loan, reservation, and fine due is listed here.

The online catalogue (OPAC) helps you check the availability and renewal of resources.

### **Issue-Return of books.**

Borrower Responsibilities -Borrowers are responsible for library materials charged out to them until they are received by the library.

### **Membership**

The faculty members, staff & students of the Institute are required to enroll as members of the LRC (upon joining the Institute) by filling in the membership form available at the LRC circulation desk (along with a passport size photograph). This entitles the use of resources & services offered for the purpose of academic and research work.



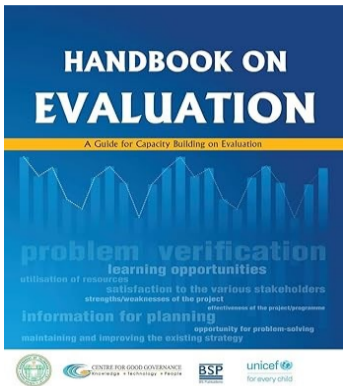
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**10. Selective Dissemination Information (SDI) :** The library offers Selective Dissemination of Information (SDI) services to cater to the specific information needs of its users. This service ensures that faculty, researchers, and students receive timely updates and relevant information tailored to their individual research interests and academic pursuits.

**11. Current Content Services:** Current Content Service (CCS) is an information service designed to keep users up-to-date with the latest publications and developments in their fields of interest. CCS involves the regular scanning and dissemination of newly published content from a wide array of sources, such as academic journals, magazines, industry and other relevant publications.

**12. Help Desk Reference Services:** It is a support function provided by IIMV Library to help users effectively find and utilize information resources. Staffed by trained librarians or information professionals, this service assists users in locating books, articles, and databases relevant to their research or study needs. Additionally, the Help Desk Reference Service offers technical support for accessing and using digital resources and online tools. Through workshops or one-on-one sessions, users can learn how to navigate and maximize the library's offerings. This service is invaluable for students, researchers, and anyone needing help with complex information needs, ensuring they can conduct thorough and efficient research.

### **1. Library outreach activities**

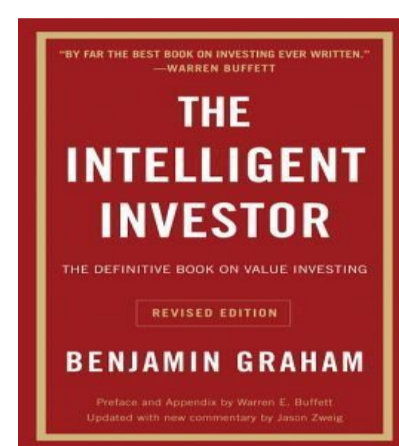
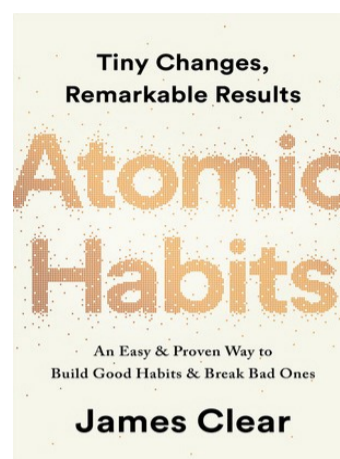
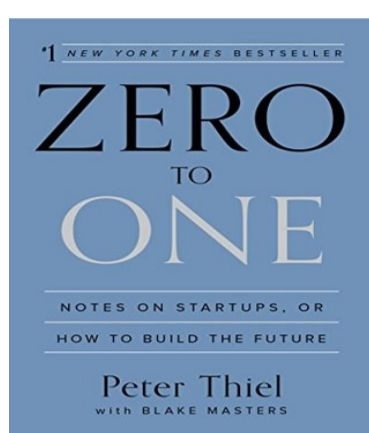
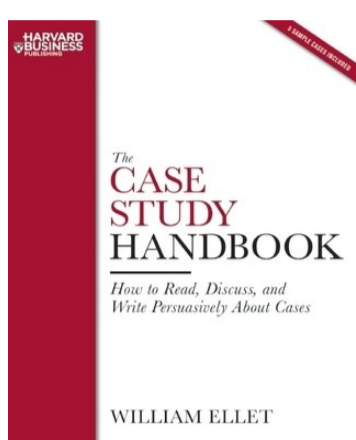
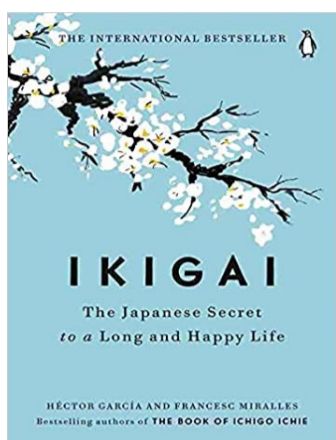

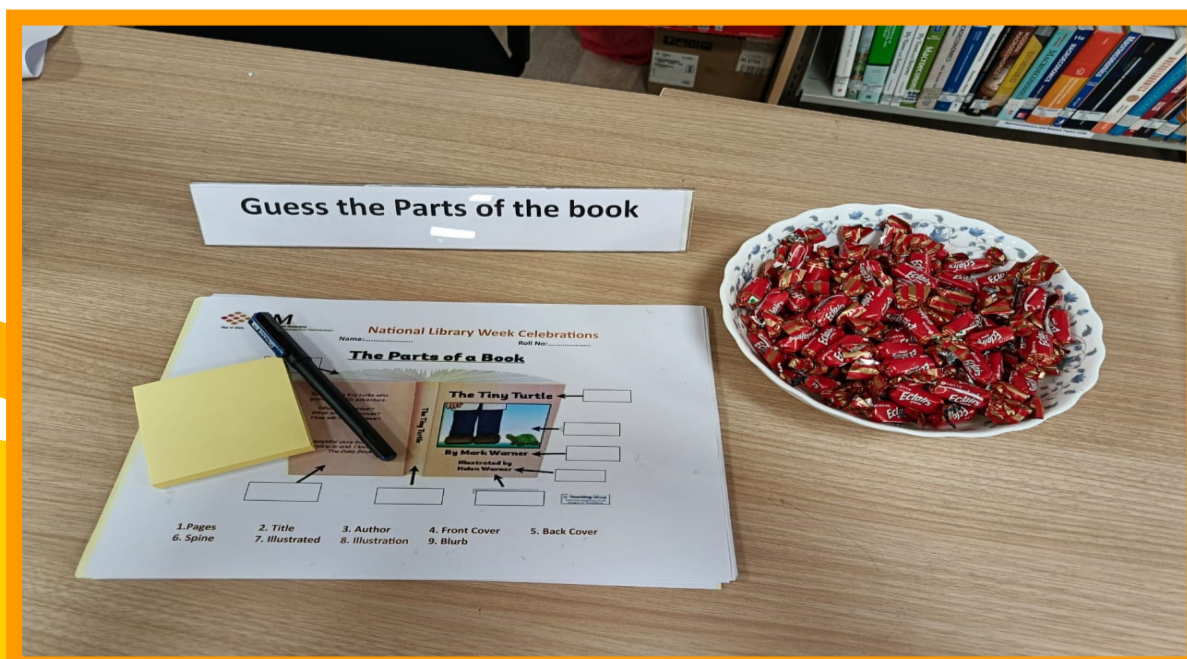


**November 15th -17th Publishers and Vendors Exhibition:** An exclusive display of the latest editions by renowned publishers and vendors
