## 8.1 Launching Library Newsletter

In the discussion room, patrons can engage in group discussions, brainstorm ideas, and collaborate on assignments or study sessions





#### 8.9.2 Fact Set




er for this event.

### 8.10 Trail Access

### 8.10.1 Bloomberg

#### 8.10.2 Fact Set

Following the demonstration session on Factset database, the library has offered 15 days trial access to the platform for the faculty and scholars. This trial period ran from July 25, 2024 to August 8, 2024.



During this period, users were granted access to Factset comprehensive suite of financial tools and data, which included real-time market information, economic reports, and investment research. The trial was intended to provide faculty and scholars with the opportunity to explore and assess the database features, enabling them to evaluate its usefulness for their research and academic requirements.

## 8.10.3 WorkSpace

Following the demonstration session on the Factset database, the library has offered 15 days trial access to the platform for faculty and scholars. This trial period ran from July 25, 2024 to August 8, 2024.



Throughout this time, users were provided access to Workspace extensive suite of financial tools and data, which included real-time market information, economic reports, and investment research. The trial was designed to allow faculty and scholars to explore and evaluate the database's features, assisting them in determining its relevance and value for their research and academic pursuits.

### 8.10.4 Labour Law Reporter


